#### A. About Financial Assistance from L.E.A.P.

- 1. **LEAP** wants to help provide funding for the tuition and other school expenses of students who are in need and who qualify for assistance. At present, **LEAP** will award each approved college student a scholarship of up to \$300.00 USD (three hundred US dollars) per semester.
- 2. To be approved for assistance, or for continuing assistance, **LEAP** requires a college student to maintain a <u>GPA of at least 2.5</u>.
- 3. It is LEAP's desire, not only to educate, but to educate educators. Therefore, at some point while you are receiving scholarship assistance for college, LEAP may want to direct your attention to certain employment opportunities in the field of education in Liberia, that LEAP is interested in seeing filled. Upon graduation from college, this could be an opportunity for you to have immediate employment as a teacher and to gain job experience. Please know that any obligation to work with LEAP in this way, following your graduation from college, would be for a clearly-defined period of time.

### B. Instructions for Completing this Application to L.E.A.P.

- 1. As a college student, you will need to submit an application for assistance every semester.
- 2. Please <u>print clearly</u> when you provide the information that is required. And <u>be truthful</u>. If this form is incomplete or inaccurate, the processing of your application could be delayed or terminated.
- 3. The board of LEAP requires you, the applicant, to describe any family relationship that may exist between you and any current LEAP board member and/or LEAP representative (see questions 7. and 8. in the fill-in portion of this application form). If you are related to a LEAP board member or representative, that person will be excluded from all scholarship award discussions regarding you. Furthermore, as the relative of either a LEAP board member or a LEAP representative, you will be required to comply with certain LEAP policies in order to receive LEAP scholarship money.
- 4. If this is your first time applying to **LEAP** for assistance for college, then you will need to include letters of recommendation with this application form. Even if you have received assistance from **LEAP** in the past for any part of your earlier (high school) education, you will still need the letters of recommendation described below, in order to receive further assistance from **LEAP** for your college education:
  - a. If you are entering your first year of college, submit two letters of recommendation:
     One from one of your high school teachers (or from your high school principal) and one from your pastor (or a reputable Christian ministry leader or community leader who knows you well).

-OR-

b. If you are entering your second year of college, or beyond, submit three letters of recommendation:
 One from one of your college instructors, one from the college administration, and one from your pastor (or a reputable Christian leader or community leader who knows you well).

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- 5. If you are applying for assistance for your first year of college education, then you will need to submit photocopies of your <a href="https://example.com/high.school/diploma">high school/diploma</a> and your <a href="https://example.com/WAEC certificate">WAEC certificate</a>. Your <a href="https://example.com/LEAP">LEAP</a> representative may want to see your <a href="https://example.com/original/documents">original documents</a>. If you do not have these documents yet, then you will need to give photocopies of them to your <a href="https://example.com/original/documents">LEAP</a> representative, as soon as you are able to do so.
- 6. Each year that you apply, *LEAP* will need a <u>recent</u>, <u>good-quality</u>, <u>color photograph</u> of you. Feel free to ask your *LEAP* representative to take this picture for you, so that *LEAP* can have this photo as a high-resolution computer file.
- 7. Before submitting your completed application and other requirements, make sure that you have not forgotten anything! The <u>checklist</u> at the end of this application form should help.
- 8. You must <u>contact your *LEAP* representative</u> in Liberia, either in person or by phone, to receive instructions regarding how your application form and the other supporting documents are to be submitted. Do NOT send them by a friend, or by any other means, unless you have the representative's prior approval.

#### F. Checklist for Submitting Your Application to L.E.A.P.

Before submitting your application, make sure that you have not overlooked anything. To help you, here is a list of the items you need to submit to your *LEAP* representative:

- 1. <u>APPLICATION FORM</u>: Have you completely filled in all parts of the application form that apply to you? Have you printed all the information clearly?
- **2.** <u>LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION</u>: Have you included the required letters of recommendation: three for first-year college students, two for returning college students (see section B.4.)
- **3.** <u>HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA</u>: If you are starting college, have you included a photocopy of your high school diploma, or will you submit it later? Are you prepared to show your *LEAP* representative your original high school diploma?
- **4.** <u>WAEC CERTIFICATE</u>: If you are starting college, have you included a photocopy of your West Africa Examination Council certificate 12<sup>th</sup> grade certificate, or will you submit it later? Are you prepared to show your *LEAP* representative your original WAEC certificate?
- 5. <u>PHOTO</u>: Have you included a recent, high-quality photo of yourself (or instead, have you asked your *LEAP* representative to take this picture for you)?
